Motivated by a desire to ensure young people's dignity and future, Don Bosco set up trade workshops to help his youngsters find work and negotiating contracts for them to prevent exploitation. The Salesian Vocational Training Centre came into existence in Valdocco, Turin, to meet specific needs of young people integrating them within an overall project

of education and evangelisation of the young, especially those most in need.

Vocational training is an effective tool for holistic human development and an effective measure to prevent youth problems, promoting Christian leadership within society and development in the business world.

WHO DOES IT? The Educative Community

Salesian religious and lay people are fully involved in an educational and pastoral role, according to the Salesian project, their professional competences, subject to regular updating. Their ethical approach and professional touch enhances interpersonal relationships that help students to develop a solid value-based foundation for life.
